

# Changes to Child Care Subsidy (CCS)

## Cheaper Child Care

The Australian Government has passed legislation to allow for more affordable child care. As a result, there will be an increase in the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) rates from July 2023.

On 23rd November 2022, the Australian Parliament passed legislation, which means the following;

- CCS for families earning \$80,000 or less will be increased to 90%
- Increase CCS rates for around 96% of families with a child in care earning under \$530,000
- A family on a combined income of \$120,000 with one child will be \$1780 better off in the first year under these reforms
- Under the legislation, these measures will be implemented from July 2023
